

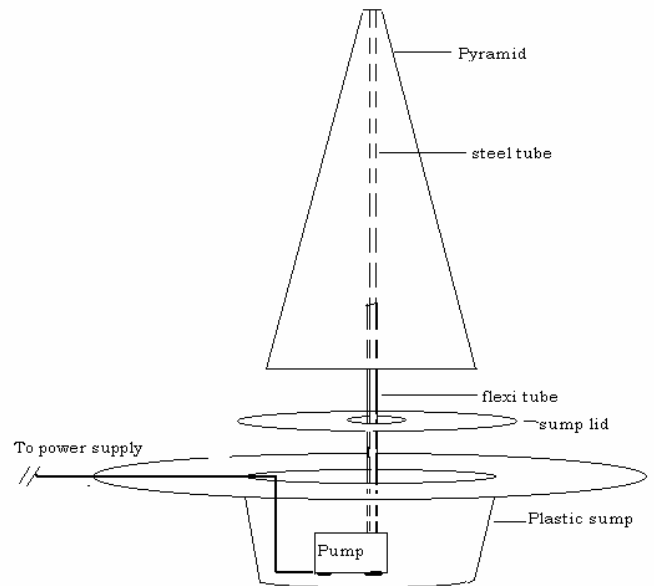
### Assembly Instructions

If fitting into the ground, dig a hole, approximately 39cm diameter by 20cm deep. Insert the pebble pool and fill with water. Screw the stainless steel pipe into the inside of your pyramid (if it is not already fitted), which should have the plastic hose connected to it. Add the plastic cap to the pebble pool, then connect the pond pump to the hose. Place the feature over the pebble pool and place pond pump into the water. Run the cable under the sump lid and on to your power supply. **It is strongly recommended that you use an RCD with all outdoor products.**

Before decorating, test that you have the desired effect of water, if not use the flow adjuster on your pump to alter.

It may help the water and pyramid, if you add a chlorine tablet. This should help keep the water clean. (Try aquatic centres for stocks).
